

LINCOLN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

LOAN OF TEXTBOOKS TO NON-PUBLIC STUDENTS

Lincoln residents whose children attend non-public schools are eligible to borrow the following textbooks for the 2009-2010 school year: Grades K-12, Science, Math, Modern Foreign Language, English/Language Arts and History/Social Studies textbooks. The return of books that were borrowed for the 2008-2009 school year and/or applications for the loan of textbooks during the 2009-2010 school year must be completed using the following schedule.

Textbooks that were borrowed for the 2008-2009 school year must be returned to the Lincoln School Department. **THE DROP OFF LOCATION WILL BE AT THE LINCOLN HIGH SCHOOL COMMUNITY ROOM (back of building) June 17, 2009, through June 19, 2009 from 9:00AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00PM.** Upon return, books will be inspected for damage. Fees will be assessed for books that have been written in or damaged in excess of normal wear and tear. Borrowers of books that are not returned will be charged the replacement cost of the book and will not be issued books unless replacement costs have been paid. Late application for books that require ordering of new books will not be honored.

Orders for the school year 2009-2010 must be placed at the location noted above June 17, 18, 19. HOURS: 9:00 AM TO 12:00 PM AND 1:00 PM TO 3:00 PM. When placing your order, you must provide complete title, author, publisher, copyright date and 13 digit ISBN. Requests for books for the 2009-2010 school year will not be honored until all books currently on loan have been returned. Books must be on the state approved list of textbooks.

Textbooks for the 2009-2010 school year can be picked up August 19, 20, 21, 2009 at the location noted above. PLEASE NOTE HOURS: 9:00 AM TO 12:00 PM AND 1:00 PM TO 3:00 PM.
